Minnesota Passes PIR Law!

Minnesota became the **fifth state** to pass a PIR law this year, thanks to the leadership of MN prosecutors and following three years of collaboration with FTP. **CA, OR, WA,** and **IL** have all passed their own PIR laws as well.

900+ People Resentenced

Since 2019, **900+ people have been safely resentenced** through Prosecutor-Initiated Resentencing (PIR) across the country, thanks to the stewardship of innovative prosecutors, community leaders, and defense attorneys.



DA Convening at San Quentin Prison

We hosted our third annual convening for the **California County Resentencing Pilot**. It is the nation's first PIR pilot, appropriating \$18M to nine CA counties to do this work. This year, we brought DA partners into a prison (some for the first time) and held strategic work sessions.

American Bar Association Resolution

The American Bar Association, the largest and oldest legal association in the country, passed a resolution **urging the federal government and all states to adopt** Prosecutor-Initiated Resentencing laws. For The People successfully advanced the resolution to the ABA House of Delegates.
