## Minnesota Passes PIR Law!

Minnesota became the **fifth state** to pass a PIR law this year, thanks to the leadership of MN prosecutors and following three years of collaboration with FTP. **CA, OR, WA,** and **IL** have all passed their own PIR laws as well.

## 900+ People Resentenced

Since 2019, **900+ people** have been safely **resentenced** through Prosecutor-Initiated Resentencing (PIR) across the country, thanks to the stewardship of innovative prosecutors, community leaders, and defense attorneys.

## DA Convening at San Quentin Prison

We hosted our third annual convening for the **California County Resentencing Pilot**. It is the nation's first PIR pilot, appropriating \$18M to nine CA counties to do this work. This year, we brought DA partners into a prison (some for the first time) and held strategic work sessions.

## American Bar Association Resolution

The American Bar Association, the largest and oldest legal association in the country, passed a resolution **urging the federal government and all states to adopt** Prosecutor-Initiated Resentencing laws. For The People successfully advanced the resolution to the ABA House of Delegates.

## Data Automation with UC Berkeley

We partnered with UC Berkeley’s Possibility Lab to develop a data automation tool that will reduce time spent on the manual, time-consuming elements of PIR and streamline initial case review for prosecutors. The tool is currently in beta and will launch in 2024.
